There's a lot to consider when choosing a network and it helps to look at your lifestyle to make sure it is a good fit for you. The scenarios below illustrate common lifestyle considerations and how the Minnesota Twin Cities Limited Network option may fit in these situations using BlueHPN.



## HAN NEEDS IN-NETWORK DOCTORS WHEN HE TRAVELS

Han is in good health and doesn't expect to spend a lot on healthcare this year. He does, however, travel for work from the Minnesota Twin Cities area to other major metropolitan cities. He needs a network that lets him get in-network primary care while traveling should he need it, plus coverage for urgent or emergency care.



BlueHPN **may be a good option** for Han because it provides access to in-network providers in most states, including more than 65 major U.S. cities. It is recommended that Hans checks to make sure BlueHPN has providers in the cities in which he travels.



## ELLA NEEDS A TRUSTWORTHY, LOCAL PRIMARY CARE DOCTOR

Ella and her family recently moved to the Minnesota Twin Cities area and are looking for a new primary care doctor. Her family's health is her top priority, but she likes to keep a close eye on her finances, too. She's looking for a plan that helps her save money but doesn't compromise her ability to get care from an experienced, local provider that can help her family stay healthy.



BlueHPN **may be a good option** for Ella since it provides access to local, high-quality providers at a lower cost.



## JIM NEEDS A DOCTOR FOR HIS DAUGHTER AWAY AT SCHOOL

Jim lives in the Minnesota Twin Cities area and his daughter just graduated high school. She's planning to attend school in Wyoming. Because his daughter has diabetes, she will need access to doctors while she's away. However, Wyoming does not have any providers in the Blue High Performance Network.



Jim **may want to consider another network** so his daughter can still receive in-network care while she's away. BlueHPN does not have in-network providers available in all cities and there is no coverage for out-of-network services except for emergencies. Check to make sure providers in your area are covered.
