What is a Shrink Sleeve?

A shrink sleeve is a type of printed label that allows full-body coverage and 360° branding of the container to which it is applied. The finished label covers the container without visible gaps.

How are They Made?

Shrink sleeves are an alternative to ordinary labels applied with an adhesive. Heat is used during the label application process, allowing the label to conform to fit nearly any size or shape of container. The labels themselves are made from a plastic film material such as:

- Oriented polystyrene (OPS)
- Polyethylene terephthalate glycol (PETG)
- Polyvinyl chloride (PVC)


